Trial Instructions and Guidelines

Please read carefully, sign the COVID-19 Waiver (included with this premium) and include signed waiver with your entry. **Only entries with a signed COVID-19 waiver will be accepted and processed into the trial.**

With the safety of exhibitors, volunteers and staff, and adherence to State and CDC requirements and guidelines, the Blue Ridge Agility Club (BRAC) has put in place the following procedures for our agility trial at the Smokey Mountain Event Center in Waynesville, NC; on October 2, 3 & 4, 2020.

If you do not feel you can comply with any of these requirements please do not enter our trial, we will look forward to seeing you at a future BRAC trial.

1. You are required to sign the COVID-19 waiver, included with this premium, and enclose it with your entry. Entries received without a waiver will not be processed into the trial.
2. Rules and guidelines provided here are subject to change. Updates will be provided prior to closing. Competitors wishing to withdraw prior to closing due to procedures required for participation can withdraw their entry at any time prior to closing. After closing, competitors may withdraw only due to illness or under quarantine due to COVID-19 exposure.
3. Social distancing of 6ft or more will be in practice at all times. At no time should there be any congregating in aisles. There should be no groups sitting together in the stands other than those in the same household or traveling together.
4. **MASKS ARE REQUIRED AT ALL TIMES WHEN UNDER COVERED ARENA**, and outside of the covered arena when social distancing cannot be maintained. We encourage MASKS to be worn during your run. We plan to provide access to disposable masks, which are more breathable, for use in the ring. If you choose to run without a mask, your mask must immediately be put back on BEFORE leaving the ring.
5. Walkthroughs will be reduced in numbers to allow for social distancing, and MASKS MUST BE WORN while walking. While walking, please be considerate and follow a minimum of 6 ft social distancing. The exact number and size of walkthroughs will be determined after closing, but in no instance will be over 25 handlers per walk. We hope to assign you to a walkthrough group (like NAC or Invitationals) and this will be marked on the running order sent to you with the final confirmation, so you know when you are walking. Groups will enter only through the ring entry and exit only through the ring exit.

Please bring with you the following:

- Hand sanitizer/Wipes – we will provide as well.
- Lunch, Snack & Drinks (no food will be available and no MACH/PACH cakes are allowed 😞)
- Mask(s) – You must wear a mask at all times under the covered arena. **AT PRESENT WE ARE NOT REQUIRING BUT ENCOURAGING THAT YOU WEAR A MASK WHEN RUNNING YOUR DOG** – if this changes we will announce the change before closing. (workers will wear masks at all times) The judge may at their discretion wear a mask/faceguard.
- Gloves if you wish to wear them.
- **A leash** that fits in your pocket or around your waist or crossbody during your run. Per AKC guidelines: “exhibitors may choose to place leashes in their pockets or wear them (around waist, crossbody, etc.) during their runs. If the dog grabs the leash this will be scored as "E". If the leash falls out of the handler's pocket, or off of their body, there is no call unless the dog were to grab it.” A leash-runner, using a bucket to transport your leash, will be available for exhibitors who do not wish to carry their leash while on course.
- Use your phone/Ipad camera, or bring a digital camera, for taking pictures of the results, course maps etc.
- Pen for recording your results, marking gate sheets, etc.

BRAC will sanitize equipment and BRAC will disinfect all surfaces, before the event and after each day of the event using EPA-registered disinfectants. BRAC will not provide PPE.

Gate sheets will be posted where individuals can check in, with sheets moved to the gate when walk starts; after movement, check-in will only be by gate steward.

Crating – under cover crating will be available, on a limited basis and 6 ft distance must be maintained. There is plenty of parking with ample space for pop up tents, and weather is generally good that time of year for crating out of your car.

Course Maps for each day will be posted on Tina Eastman’s trial secretary’s website after 6 p.m. Thursday evening, Friday evening and Saturday evening. You will receive an email to let you know that the course-maps have been posted, along with a link to the website location. Daily course maps will be hung in various places around the arena as well.

Ribbons will be available, self serve. Results stickers will be made available when results are posted. We ask that you maintain social distancing when collecting your ribbons and stickers, and no lingering. Results will be emailed to you as soon as possible and posted in two places on a wall with plenty of spacing for viewing after the class is over. THERE WILL BE NO MONITORS AVAILABLE with scrolling results while a class is running. Please maintain social distancing when looking at results and bring a camera to record results. Additionally, all results for each day will be posted on the Tina Eastman’s trial secretary’s website at the end of each trial day.

Only ring crew and our designated course builders will touch the equipment.

There will be no Master/Excellent briefings prior to running. We will provide a general master/excellent briefing on our website and provide in your judging schedule with your final confirmation. Copies will also be posted in a couple of areas at the trial site. Briefings **will** be held for Novice/Open. Please be considerate, wear a mask and exercise social distancing during these briefings.

Measuring dogs – Only entered dogs will be measured. Karen Wloldarski is a VMO and will measure. The final confirmation will include information on measuring.

BRAC is looking forward to helping restart AKC agility in Western North Carolina, and we are prepared to make this a safe and fun trial. We realize this is a “no frills” trial and is different to what we are used to pre COVID. However, the health and safety of everyone is paramount if we wish to run agility at this time. If during the trial you are unable to follow these procedures, we will ask you to leave and your entry fees will not be refunded. We want everyone to be safe.

Judging will start no earlier than 8 a.m. each day—Your Final Confirmation and Trial Information, emailed after the close of the trial, will provide details on start times each day. Heights will be low to high Friday, high to low Saturday and low to high Sunday.

Open and Novice FAST will walk together and run all Open then all Novice (unless numbers are such that 2 walks are required).

FEO is offered at this trial (T2B and FAST only)

Please consult the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials for a complete description and eligibility for entry into these classes. The exhibitor is fully responsible for entering the dog in the correct class(es)/height divisions. Dogs running in a lower height division than they are eligible for will be eliminated.

DOG ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate.

Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word “dog” is used in these regulations it includes both sexes.

Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Puppies under four (4) months of age are strictly prohibited from the trial grounds

ENTRY FEES PER DAY

Fees include AKC recording fees of \$3.50 for each first entry of each dog each day & \$3.00 for each additional entry of same dog each day.

Move ups must be sent in writing (e-mail is acceptable and preferred) to the Trial Secretary for **the Oct 2, 2020 trial, no later than Monday, Sept 28, by 6:00 PM.** Move ups from Friday to Saturday, Saturday to Sunday must be submitted in person to the trial secretary no later than 15 minutes after the last class on Friday & Saturday.

CLASS CHANGES EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2020

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY!

ENTERING A MIXTURE OF REGULAR AND PREFERRED CLASSES WITHIN THE SAME TRIAL WEEKEND – MULTIPLE JUMP HEIGHTS WITHIN THE SAME TRIAL DAY

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend – Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day

As of January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

When calculating entry fees, treat multiple entry forms for the same dog as if only one form had been filled out. In other words, the 1st run entry fee is only paid once per day, per dog, even if that dog's runs have been submitted on multiple entry forms.

FIX AND GO ON (FNG)

As of January 1, 2020, Fix and Go On will be offered on a one-year pilot basis in order to give AKC time to evaluate its impact. FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score.

Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run.

ENTERING FOR EXHIBITION ONLY (FEO)

As of January 1, 2020, For Exhibition Only may be offered at the option of the host club. FEO will be offered on a one-year pilot basis in order to give AKC time to evaluate its impact. FEO will allow exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is only allowed in the Time 2 Beat and FAST classes. FEO will be of value to new exhibitors or exhibitors that are having difficulty with a specific obstacle and/or ring environment. Competitors must enter in T2B and/or FAST. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.

- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) (T2B and/or FAST) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.
- Dogs may be entered in any level of FAST (Novice, Open, Excellent, Master). If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out. FEO may be declared earlier (ex. when checking in at the gate board).
- Toys are allowed in the ring
 - Toys must be non-audible
 - Toys may not leave the handler's hand
 - Toys that roll freely cannot be used
- Food/treats are not allowed in the ring
- FEO should be utilized for the benefit of the dog and not as a punitive correction. Harsh verbal and /or physical corrections shall not be tolerated. Any determination of harshness by the judge shall be immediately whistled and the handler will be dismissed from the ring.
- A judge must monitor the entire run. Judges can stop a run at any time

WAIT LIST

BRAC is offering a Wait List to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial's closing date/time. A maximum of 25 entries will be placed on the club's wait list. All entries, including wait listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to Sept 25, 2020 @ 11:00pm, the event's closing date/time of this trial. Any entries withdrawn that are received by noon on Monday, Sept 28, 2020, will be replaced by a wait listed entry if any are available. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait listed entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry. Any wait listed entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial by noon on Monday, September 28, 2020 will receive a full refund.

PLEASE NOTE:

Effective 1/2/18, the 26-inch jump height division is replaced by the 24-Choice jump height division.

MEASURING AND HEIGHT CARD INFORMATION

Jump height cards are not required to be submitted with the entry form. The jump height box on the entry form MUST be filled in.

Karen Wlodarski will be providing VMO measurements.

OBSTACLES AND RING CONDITIONS

Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials. Indoor, heated arena on packed dirt. 24" spaced weave poles; Rubber contacts, plastic jumps with single moveable jump-cups, displaceable tire, and electronic timers, (2) 100' x 100' rings.

WALK-THROUGHS AND Warm-Up INFORMATION

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, during a walk-through period held prior to the start of the class. The walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in that class only and will be limited to a maximum of 25 handlers. Handlers with multiple dogs/conflicts: Tell the gate-steward if you need to move your dog, they will help you manage your conflict.

A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, will be provided for exhibitors. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the dog and not for training or relieving of the dog.

RINGSIDE - Dogs may arrive any time prior to judging if the dog has a valid temporary or permanent jump height card. Otherwise, they must be available for measuring prior to the start of their class if a VMO or AKC Field Rep is available to measure dogs. All dogs not needed for further judging will be excused.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

BIS REFUND

Bitches in season will not be admitted to the trial. Any exhibitor with a bitch entered, which is in season on the trial date, will be refunded the entry fee, less \$3 per run (each day), upon written certification from a veterinarian. Notification must be in the hands of the trial secretary no later than 30 minutes before the start time on the first day of the trials. (Friday, Oct 2).

Injury/Illness – Dogs that cannot compete prior to the set of trials due to an injury/illness will be given a partial refund minus processing fees of \$6.50 per run. A written vet letter (on office letterhead) must be given to the Trial Secretary no later than 30 minutes before the start time on Oct 2, 2020. **Injuries/illness to handlers are excluded from this policy**

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely. It is expressly understood that the exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any entry fees will be made. All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. No dogs may be left tied to trees, cars, fences, etc.

Dogs under 4 months of age are not allowed at this trial. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that the dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run. No classes will be held up by a late exhibitor.

This club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC Entry Form for this event.

AKC RULES AND REGULATIONS

All exhibitors should obtain a copy of the Regulations for Agility Trials by downloading them from the American Kennel Club website at <http://www.akc.org/rules/>.

PRIZES AND AWARDS

Ribbons or rosettes will be awarded to the 1st through 4th place teams in each jump height in each class. Dogs must qualify to receive placement ribbons. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving qualifying scores. Teams earning a title will receive a new title rosette. MACH and PACH rosettes and bars will be awarded to dogs that earn those titles at this trial.

All ribbons must be claimed by the end of the Trial; none will be mailed.

FOOD, SNACKS AND BEVERAGES

Plan to bring your own food, snacks and water/beverages. We may have a food truck onsite. There are also fast food and take out restaurants close by.

VENDOR INFORMATION
